Chapter 265.

An Act in relation to the Maine State Pythian Relief Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Association,
made subject to
ch. 237, Public
Laws of 1889.

The Maine State Pythian Relief Association is hereby made subject to the provisions of section six of chapter two hundred and thirty-seven of the public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, entitled "An Act relating to Life and Casualty Insurance on the Assessment plan."

Chapter 266.

An Act to authorize the Rockland and Thomaston Gas Light Company to enter upon the business of Electric Lighting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Company,
authorized to
manufacture
electric current
and purchase
plant.

SECT. 1. The Rockland and Thomaston Gas Light Company, first having obtained the consent of all the stockholders, is hereby authorized to add to its business the manufacture of electric current for the production of light and power, and the sale of the same ; and to that end may purchase the electric light plant now existing in the city of Rockland.

Capital stock,
increased.

SECT. 2. For the carrying on and development of this business, the said company may increase its capital stock to an amount not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 267.

An Act to amend the charter of the Castine Railway and Navigation Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :
