Chapter 297.

An Act to prevent the taking of land-locked salmon from Flying Pond, located between the towns of Mount Vernon and Vienna, in the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from taking or catching any land-locked salmon from Flying pond, located between the towns of Mount Vernon and Vienna, in the county of Kennebec, for the term of four years from the approval of this act.

Taking of land-locked salmon from Flying pond for 4 years, prohibited.

SECT. 2. Any person, who shall violate the provisions of this act, shall pay the sum of five dollars for each fish taken, to be recovered on complaint before any trial justice in said county of Kennebec, one-half to the use of the complainant and the other half to the use of said county.

Penalty for violation.

Approved March 25, 1891.

Chapter 298.

An Act for the protection of pickerel and white perch in Androscoggin pond and its tributaries, located in the towns of Leeds and Wayne in the counties of Androscoggin and Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. No person shall sell, expose for sale, or have in possession with intent to sell, or transport from place to place any pickerel or white perch, taken from Androscoggin pond or its tributaries, between the first days of October and the following May, under a penalty of not less than ten nor more than twenty dollars for each offense, and one dollar for each fish so taken. But this act shall not prohibit the taking of such fish from said pond or its tributaries, for consumption in the family of the person taking them.

Sale or transportation of fish taken in Androscoggin pond between Oct. 1 and May 1, prohibited.

SECT. 2. Whoever at any time catches, takes, kills or fishes for any pickerel or white perch in said pond or its tributaries by means of grapnel or spear, or in any other way than by the ordinary mode of angling with a baited hook and line or with artificial flies, for fish, not less than ten nor more than twenty dollars for each offense, and one dollar for every fish so taken.

Penalty, for taking fish with grapnel or spear.
