SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

CHAP. 339

Approved April 3, 1891.

Chapter 339.

An Act to set off certain property in Foxcroft from the limits of the Dover and Foxcroft Village Fire Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The territory in Foxcroft covered by the residences and land connected therewith of William McComb, Freeman H. Jackson, Lewis C. Dexter, Danville P. Oaks, George W. Colcord, Charles B. Sherburne, Luther Garland and John F. Martin, is hereby set off from the limits of the Dover and Foxcroft Village Fire Company.

Territory, set off from limits of Dover and Foxcroft Village Fire Co.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
