Chapter 21.

Resolve in favor of Swanville.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of state out of the school funds of the current year, to the town of Swanville the sum of twenty-nine dollars and eighty-nine cents, it being a balance equitably due said town as its proportion of the school funds for the year eighteen hundred and ninety.

Chapter 22.

Resolve in favor of helping maintain road from Patten to Crystal Plantation.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated four hundred dollars to aid in maintaining the road leading from Patten Village in a southerly direction across Crystal Plantation to Sherman. The same to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

Road between Patten and Crystal plantation, in favor of.

Approved February 25, 1891.

Chapter 23.

Resolve in favor of Macwahoc Plantation.

Resolved, That seven hundred and fifty dollars be appropriated for repairs of bridge across the Macwahoc Stream, the same to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.
