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**Chapter 69.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Passadumkeag.

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of four hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of the county of Penobscot, to repair the bridge over the Passadumkeag stream, in the town of Passadumkeag, on the military road from Bangor to Houlton.

**Chapter 70.**

Resolve in favor of William Dow of Tremont.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the treasury of the state to William Dow of Tremont, the sum of six dollars per month as a military pension commencing January first, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, and until such time as he shall receive a government pension.

**Chapter 71.**

Resolve in favor of the committee on the State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

*Resolved,* That the state treasurer be directed to pay to Loring R. Giles, chairman of the committee on the State College of Agriculture and Mechanic Arts, the sum of ninety-four dollars and seventy-five cents, the same being the amount paid by him for expenses of said committee on its recent visit to the college in accordance with the order of the legislature.
