### Снар. 186

### Chapter 186.

An Act to amend Section thirty-one of Chapter three of the Revised Statutes, relating to Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Sec. 31, ch. 3, R. S., amended. SECT. 1. Section thirty-one of chapter three of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words, "votes cast" in the second and third lines of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'registered voters of such city,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

'SECT. 31. No change made by the city council, in the limits of any city ward, shall be valid unless it is approved by a majority of the legal registered voters of such city, at the election of city officers, held next after such action of said council; and warrants for such ward meetings shall contain an article for that purpose.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 187

An Act to repeal chapter one hundred and eleven of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, relating to Fraternal Beneficiary Associations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Chapter one hundred and eleven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An Act to restore to certain corporations, rights of which they were deprived by the repeal of chapter three hundred and seventythree of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five," is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
