Chapter 272.

An Act to amend Chapter eighty-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, entitled "An Act relating to Madawaska Training School."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Section three of chapter eighty-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, is hereby amended in the second line thereof, by substituting for the word "thirteen" the word 'sixteen,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

Sec. 3. ch. 82, Pub. Laws, 1887, amended.

SECT. 3. To defray the current expenses of said school, the sum of sixteen hundred dollars is hereby annually appropriated from the school funds of the state, in the same manner as appropriations are made for the other state normal schools.'

Appropriation.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Inconsistent acts, repealed.

Chapter 273.

An Act providing for the form of warrant for the commitment of taxes under the provisions of Sections one hundred and forty-seven and one hundred and forty-nine of chapter six of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The warrant to be issued by the assessors for the completion of the collection of taxes under the provisions of sections one hundred and forty-seven and one hundred and forty-nine of chapter six of the revised statutes shall be in substance as follows:

Warrant for collection of taxes.

ss. A. B., constable, or collector of the town of _____
within the county of _____ :

In the name of the state of Maine, you are hereby required to levy and collect of such of the several persons named in the list herewith committed unto you, his respective proportion therein set down, of the sum total of such list, amounting in the aggregate to _____ dollars and _____ cents, it being the unpaid portion of the taxes assessed in the town of _____ for the year _____, for state, county
