CHAP. 345**Chapter 345.**

An Act relating to the Rumford Falls and Buckfield Railroad Company and the Portland and Rumford Falls Railway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Locations, made valid.

SECT. 1. All railroad locations heretofore made by either of the railroad companies mentioned in the title of this act, including the location by the Portland and Rumford Falls Railway, of the extension of its railroad from Mechanic Falls, in the town of Minot, through the town of Poland to a point of connection with the Maine Central Railroad, near George W. Hackett's farm, in the city of Auburn, as filed in the county commissioners' office for Androscoggin county on the sixth day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, are hereby ratified, approved and affirmed as legal and valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 346.

An Act authorizing the town of Hampden to accept a legacy for the benefit of Hampden Academy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Town of Hampden, authorized to accept legacy for benefit of academy.

SECT. 1. The town of Hampden in the county of Penobscot is hereby authorized to accept the legacy of ten thousand dollars for the benefit of Hampden Academy, upon the terms and conditions named in the will of George Stetson, and guarantee and give the bond therein named, and the vote of said town, passed March fourteen, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, accepting said legacy, and guaranteeing the interest on the same, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
