Chapter 347.

An Act relating to the Portland Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The Portland Railroad Company is hereby authorized to issue its bonds to an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, of such denomination, on such time, and at such rate of interest as it may find expedient, and to secure the same by a mortgage or deed of trust of its franchises and property, to one or more trustees, with or without a provision for a sinking fund, in order to provide funds to meet its outstanding indebtedness, and to improve and extend its system of street railroads.

Portland R. R. Co., authorized to issue bonds.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 348.

An Act to repeal chapter two hundred and seventy-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An Act to prohibit the taking of fish from Gardner Brook in the towns of Minot and Oxford."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter two hundred and seventy-seven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An Act to prohibit the taking of fish from Gardner Brook in the towns of Minot and Oxford," is hereby repealed.

Ch. 277, Special Laws, 1891, repealed.
