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CHAP. 349**Chapter 349.**

An Act to repeal chapter three hundred and eleven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An Act to prohibit the taking of trout from Bog Brook and its tributaries in the towns of Minot and Hebron."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Laws, 1891,  
repealed.

Chapter three hundred and eleven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An Act to prohibit the taking of trout from Bog Brook and its tributaries in the towns of Minot and Hebron," is hereby repealed.

**Chapter 350.**

An Act to authorize the Phillips and Rangeley Railroad Company to issue additional bonds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Company,  
authorized to  
issue bonds and  
mortgage road.

SECT. 1. The Phillips and Rangeley Railroad Company is hereby authorized and empowered to issue its bonds to an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars in addition to the amount of two hundred thousand dollars, which it has been before authorized to issue, and the said bonds may be secured by the mortgage made and executed by said company, dated October four, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-two, recorded in Franklin registry of deeds, book one hundred and twenty-seven, pages thirty-one to forty-one inclusive, which mortgage is hereby ratified, confirmed and authorized, or in any other way or manner it may deem proper.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
