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**Chapter 368.**

An Act to amend the charter of the Master, Wardens and Members of Amity Lodge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. Section one of chapter ninety of the special laws of eighteen hundred and twenty-two, is hereby amended by striking out the word "three" before the word "thousand" in the twelfth line thereof, and the word "five" before the word "thousand" in the fourteenth line thereof, and inserting in the place of each the word 'twenty-five,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows :

Sec. 1, ch. 90,

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives in legislature assembled, That Jonas Wheeler, Frederick Jacobs and Joseph W. Thorndike and their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the name of the master, wardens and members of Amity Lodge ; with power to sue and be sued ; to have a common seal, and to change the same ; to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs not repugnant to the laws of this state nor to ancient masonic usages ; to take and hold for charitable and benevolent uses, any real estate to the value of twenty-five thousand dollars, and any personal estate to the value of twenty-five thousand dollars ; and to give and grant or bargain and sell the same ; and with all the privileges usually granted to other societies instituted for the purposes of charity and beneficence.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 369.**

An Act to extend the charter of the Old Town Street Railway Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The period within which the Old Town Street Railway Company must have organized and commenced actual business under its charter, is hereby extended until the second day of March, eighteen hundred and ninety-five.
