CHAP. 428**Chapter 428.**

An Act to make valid the doings of the First Freewill Baptist Parish in Gorham, and to change the name of said corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Doings of First
Free Will Bap-
tist Parish of
Gorham, made
valid.

SECT. 1. The doings and proceedings of the First Freewill Baptist Parish in Gorham, in its organization, meetings, election of officers and records, and in acquiring and conveying real and personal estate, are hereby confirmed and made valid, notwithstanding any informalities in past proceedings or records.

Name changed.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to take and use hereafter the name of the White Rock Free Baptist Parish.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 429.

An Act to authorize the Hickory Wheel Company to hold and sell stock, bonds and property of other corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Company, au-
thorized to hold
stocks, etc., of
other corpora-
tions.

The Hickory Wheel Company, organized under the general laws of this state, is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase, hold, own and sell the stocks, bonds and property of other corporations, organized under the laws of this and other states, engaged in or relating to, or necessary for the business described in the articles of agreement and certificate of organization of said Hickory Wheel Company, and may vote upon said stock.
