CHAP. 436

Chapter 436.

An Act to make the Riverside Agricultural Society a beneficiary under the laws paying stipends to agricultural societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Annual stipend to Riverside Agricultural Society.

SECT. 1. The Riverside Agricultural Society of Oxford county, shall be paid the fair share of the annual stipends provided by law for agricultural societies, subject to the conditions imposed by law.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 437.

An Act to change the name of the Saccarappa Congregational Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Name of society changed, and doings made valid.

SECT. 1. The Congregational Society, which has its church edifice in Saccarappa, in the city of Westbrook, and has been called and known hitherto by the name of the Saccarappa Congregational Society, shall henceforth be called and known by the name of the Westbrook Congregational Parish, and all its acts and doings in its corporate capacity heretofore are hereby legalized and made valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
