Chapter 468.

An Act to authorize Berlin Mills Company to hold stock and bonds in other corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows.

SECT. 1. The Berlin Mills Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Maine, and having its principal office at Portland, in said state, is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, hold and dispose of shares of the capital stock and mortgage bonds of other corporations.

Berlin Mills Co., authorized to hold stock of other corporations.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 7, 1893.

Chapter 469.

An Act authorizing the Bodwell Water Power Company to hold stock and bonds of other corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The Bodwell Water Power Company of Bangor, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Maine, which organization is hereby ratified, confirmed and declared to be legal and valid, is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, hold and dispose of shares of capital stock and mortgage bonds of other corporations.

Organization of Bodwell Water Power Co., made valid, and company, authorized to hold stock of other corporations.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 7, 1893.

Chapter 470.

An Act to authorize the Inhabitants of the town of Old Orchard to purchase the franchises and property of the Old Orchard Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The inhabitants of the town of Old Orchard are hereby authorized to purchase the franchise and property of the Old Orchard Water Company, and to acquire an addi-
