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**Chapter 501.**

An Act to amend the charter of the Camden and Rockport Banking and Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. The name of the Camden and Rockport Banking and Trust Company is hereby changed to the Camden Banking and Trust Company, and the said corporation shall have its place of business in the town of Camden. Name,  
changed.

SECT. 2. Chapter four hundred and twenty-seven of the private and special laws for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, as amended by this act, is hereby revived and renewed, except so much of said charter as authorizes said company to act as administrator or guardian. Ch 427, Special  
Laws, 1889,  
revived.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 502.**

An Act to amend Section one of Chapter four hundred forty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An Act to prevent the throwing of slabs or other refuse into the Penobscot River."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. Section one of said chapter four hundred forty-eight, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "dollars" in the last line of said section, the words, 'nor shall any person or persons cast or throw into said Penobscot river below the mouth of the Mattawamkeag river or into any of its tributaries entering below the mouth of said Mattawamkeag river between the first day of November of each year and the time of the freezing up of Penobscot river, any planer shavings, and no person or persons shall so place, pile or deposit on the banks of said Penobscot river, or the banks of any of said tributaries any planer shavings in such negligent or careless manner that the same shall fall or be washed into said river or said tributaries, or with the intent that the same shall fall or be washed into said river or tributaries, between the first day of November of each year and the time of the
