**Chapter 579.**

An Act to change the close time on Perch and Bass in Hayden Lake, Somerset County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

On and after June first eighteen hundred ninety-three, and during the month of June of each and every year after the approval of this act, all persons shall be allowed to fish for perch and bass in Hayden lake or Madison pond, Somerset county.

Close time on fish in Hayden lake.

Approved March 27, 1893

**Chapter 580.**

An Act relating to fishing in the tributaries of Lermond and Alford Ponds in the county of Knox.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from fishing in any manner for fish of any kind in all of the tributaries leading into or tributary to Lermond's and Alford's ponds in the county of Knox for the term of six years.

Taking of fish from tributaries of Lermond's and Alford's ponds for six years, prohibited.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for each offense to be recovered by complaint, one-half to the use of the prosecutor and one-half to the use of the county of Knox.

Penalty.

Approved March 27, 1893.

**Chapter 581.**

An Act to prevent the taking of Fish from Drew's Lake in Aroostook County, Maine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. All persons are forbidden fishing for, or taking any fish from the waters of Drew's lake in Aroostook county, Maine, for the term of four years from the first day of April, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred ninety-three.

Taking of fish from Drew's lake for four years, prohibited.
