Chapter 591.

An Act additional to Chapter three hundred eighty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred fifty, entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of Calais."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The fire department of the city while going to and at fires shall have the right of way in the streets of the city, and it shall be the duty of all persons in the streets when an alarm of fire is given to give way to said department. The engineers shall have control of all streets adjacent to fires while in progress, and may direct the use of the same as may be for the best interests of life and property. The above provision may be regulated by ordinance of city council.

Fire department shall have right of way, when alarm of fire is given.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 592.

An Act to amend Section four of Chapter one hundred twenty-seven of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred seventy-five, relating to the place of holding the Yearly Meeting of Friends.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Section four of chapter one hundred twenty-seven of the private laws of eighteen hundred seventy-five, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows :

Sec. 4, ch. 127, Private Laws, 1875, amended.

'SECT. 4. The yearly meeting of Friends for New England, a corporation established by the legislature of Maine, is hereby authorized to hold its annual meeting in the states of Maine or Massachusetts, from time to time, as they shall see fit, and transact therein any business that may come before them, the same as if such meeting were held in the state of Rhode Island or Maine.'

When and where meeting may be held.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
