SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 651.**

An Act exempting the Maine Sportsmen's Fish and Game Association from payment of fee to Secretary of State for Certificate of Organization.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled.* as follows :

SECT. 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to issue the certificate required by chapter one hundred and forty of the private laws of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, to the Maine Sportsmen's Fish and Game Association, a corporation created by special act, without the payment of the fee required in said chapter one hundred and forty.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
