**Chapter 175.**

Resolve in favor of Castine State Normal School.

*Resolved,* That for the purpose of providing suitable water closets and sewerage for the Castine State Normal School, there be and hereby is appropriated for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three, the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars.

Castine, Normal School, in favor of.

Approved March 8, 1893.

**Chapter 176.**

Resolve in aid of building bridge across Molunkus Stream in Silver Ridge Plantation, county of Aroostook.

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars shall be and hereby is appropriated to aid in building a bridge across Molunkus stream in Silver Ridge plantation, in the county of Aroostook, said sum to be expended by the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

Bridge across Molunkus Stream, in favor of.

Approved March 8, 1893.

**Chapter 177.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Guilford.

*Resolved,* That there be paid by the treasurer of the state, out of the school funds of the current year, to the town of Guilford, the sum of two hundred ninety-two dollars and twenty-four cents, it being a balance equitably due said town as its balance of its proportion of the school fund for the year eighteen hundred ninety-one.

**Chapter 178.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts.

*Resolved,* That there be paid to the trustees of the Maine State College of Agriculture and the Mechanic Arts, the sum of twelve thousand dollars, for the use of said college for the
