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CHAP. 183**Chapter 183.**

Resolve in favor of Calais Academy.

Calais Academy,  
in favor of.

*Resolved*, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and is hereby appropriated annually, for two years to aid Calais Academy.

**Chapter 184.**

Resolve in favor of the Plantation of Lexington.

Lexington

favor of.

*Resolved*, That the state treasurer be directed to pay to the treasurer of the plantation of Lexington, the sums now standing on the books of the state treasurer apportioned to said plantation as its part of the school and mill fund tax of the years eighteen hundred ninety-one and eighteen hundred ninety-two.

**Chapter 185.**

Resolve in favor of the committee attending funeral of late William H. Libby of Standish, Maine.

*Resolved*, That the treasurer of state be directed to pay to James F. Brackett, chairman of said committee, the sum of thirty-one dollars and fifty cents, the same being the amount paid out for expenses of the committee, in attending the funeral of the late William H. Libby, at Standish, Maine, in accordance with the order of the legislature.
