a school house that shall cost not less than one thousand dollars. All the foregoing sums to be expended under the direction of the governor and council, for the purposes for which they are appropriated and for none other and any sums of money not expended for the purpose for which it was appropriated, shall not be allowed to said agent in the settlement of his account. And also the sum of ninety dollars, it being the amount due said tribe from the shore rent account of the year eighteen hundred and ninety, withheld on account of an error.

Chapter 209.

Resolve in favor of the State Reform School.

Resolved, That the sum of forty-two thousand five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the State Reform School for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-three and eighteen hundred and ninety-four for the following purposes. For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three for current expenses, including mechanical school and new cottage, eighteen thousand dollars; for ordinary repairs two thousand dollars; special repairs two thousand dollars; furnishing new cottage two thousand five hundred dollars. For the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four for current expenses, including mechanical school and new cottage, eighteen thousand dollars. And of the above named amount twenty-four thousand five hundred dollars or so much thereof as is necessary for the above named purposes shall be payable in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three and eighteen thousand dollars or so much thereof as is necessary for the above named purposes, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four.
