CHAP. 99

Penalty for neglecting duty.

SECT. 4. Any officer neglecting or refusing to perform any duty required of him by the provisions of this act, shall be fined not exceeding one hundred dollars.

Insurance commissioner shall tabulate statistics.

SECT. 5. The insurance commissioner shall classify and tabulate the statistics so obtained and shall publish them in his annual report.

Chapter 99.

An Act additional to Chapter one hundred twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes, relating to Eggs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Selling preserved eggs, without notice to purchaser, prohibited.

Whoever, by himself or his agent, sells or offers for sale eggs that have been in cold storage or limed, or that have been preserved in any manner and are not what are usually denominated fresh eggs, without notice to the purchaser or purchasers, knowingly and with intent to deceive, shall be punished by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days or by fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

Chapter 100.

An Act to fix the salaries of the Judge and Register of Probate for Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Salary of judge of probate of Waldo county, fixed.

SECT. 1. From and after the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, the salary of the judge of probate for the county of Waldo shall be three hundred and fifty dollars per year instead of the sum now fixed by law.

Salary of register, fixed.

SECT. 2. From and after the first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, the salary of the register of probate for the county of Waldo shall be five hundred dollars per year instead of the sum now fixed by law.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
