Chapter 121.

An Act to amend section one hundred and twelve of chapter eleven of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter thirty-seven of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one; and to repeal section three of chapter eighty-two of Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, as amended by chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to Normal Schools and the Madawaska Training School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Section one hundred twelve of chapter eleven of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter thirty-seven of the public laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, is hereby amended by inserting in the first line thereof, after the word "schools" the words 'and Madawaska Training School,' and by inserting in place of the words "twenty-four" in the same line, the word 'twenty-seven,' so that said section shall read as follows :

Sec. 112, ch. 11, R. S., as amended by ch. 37, of the Public Laws of 1891, amended.

SECT. 112. For the support of the three normal schools and the Madawaska Training School, twenty-seven thousand dollars is annually appropriated, to be expended under the direction of said trustees, which sum the treasurer of state shall deduct for said purpose from any school money raised for the support of common schools. The governor and council may from time to time, as they think proper, draw warrants therefor on said treasurer in favor of said trustees.'

Appropriation for Normal and Training schools.

SECT. 2. Section three of chapter eighty-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, as amended by chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the public laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3, ch. 82, Laws of 1887, as amended by ch. 272, laws of 1893, repealed.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Inconsistent acts, repealed.
