NEW SWEDEN.

'The fees received by said judge shall be payment in full CHAP. for his services, provided, that the city council of the city of Compensation of judge. Old Town may at any time by vote determine to pay him a salary which may be accepted by him instead of said fees and shall not be diminished during his term of office; and if such salary is so accepted by him, he shall pay all fees of office by him received in criminal cases into the treasury of said city of Old Town, except fees for making copies on orders to recognize and on appeals.'

SECT. 3. All provisions of said chapter one hundred and Inconsistent seventy-seven inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 7.

An Act to incorporate the town of New Sweden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Township number fifteen, range three, west from New Sweden, SECT. 1. the east line of the state, in the county of Aroostook, and town of, incorporated. known as New Sweden plantation, is hereby incorporated into a town by the name of New Sweden, and the inhabitants of said town are hereby vested with all the powers, privileges, immunities and liabilities of other towns.

Any justice of the peace within the county of Meeting for Sect. 2. Aroostook is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to some how called. inhabitant of said town, directing him to notify the inhabitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he shall appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are empowered to choose at their annual town meeting.

SECT. 3. The town hereby created shall take the effects Town shall belonging to New Sweden plantation, and shall also assume assume all obligations. all the obligations of said plantation.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
