Chapter 21.

An Act relating to the extension of time of charter of Sebasticook and Moosehead Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sebas- Rights and ticook and Moosehead Railroad Company which were granted by chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the private and extended for special laws for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one are hereby extended for four years additional.

Chapter 22.

An Act to incorporate the Washburn Bridge Company,

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Albert A. Burleigh, Thomas H. Phair and Job Corporators. Abbott, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby constituted and created a body corporate and politic by the name of the Washburn Bridge Company, and as such shall Corporate have and possess all the powers and be subject to all the name. duties and obligations conferred and imposed on corporations by law.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said corporation shall be Capital stock. twenty-eight thousand dollars, divided into shares of one hundred dollars each.
