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**Chapter 32.**

An Act additional to chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-three, relating to Little River Manufacturing Company and chapter four hundred and twenty-three, laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-five, relating to the Worumbo Manufacturing Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The Worumbo Manufacturing Company is authorized and empowered to locate, construct and maintain a railroad track and trolley wire over the same, with necessary poles and feeder wires, extending from its works in the village of Lisbon Falls and town of Lisbon to a connection with the tracks of the Maine Central Railroad Company, and to operate the same by means of electricity, for the sole purpose of transporting freight between its works and the Maine Central Railroad, provided, that it shall first obtain the consent of the municipal officers of the town of Lisbon and of the owners of the land through which said track shall be located.

Co. authorized to construct an electric railroad.

—consent of municipal officers necessary.

SECT. 2. Should the location secured require a grade crossing of the tracks of the Maine Central Railroad, the manner and conditions of such crossing shall be determined by the railroad commissioners in accordance with the provisions of section twenty-seven of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, as amended.

—Crossings, how determined.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

**Chapter 33.**

An Act to renew and amend the charter of the Van Buren Water Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. All of the provisions of chapter three hundred and twenty-four of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Van Buren Water Company," are hereby continued in force, and the said company is given a further period of two years from the date hereof in which to organize, begin building its works and commence business.

Ch. 324, Private Laws of 1891, continued in force.
