Chapter 51.

An Act relating to the Sebacitcook and Moosehead Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The Sebacitcook and Moosehead Railroad Company, a corporation existing by law in this state, is hereby authorized and empowered to extend its line of railroad from Athens village in the town of Athens, Maine, by a feasible route to some point or place at or near Monson Junction in the town of Abbot, Maine, passing through the towns of Brighton, Wellington, Kingsbury and Abbot, or any, either or all of said towns, and all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities which were given said corporation for the extension of its line of railroad from Hartland to Athens by chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the private and special laws of the state of Maine of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one, shall apply to the extension authorized by this act, including the right to erect and maintain telegraph and telephone lines.

SECT. 2. The capital stock of said corporation, may, by vote of its stockholders, be increased, from time to time, to not exceeding five thousand shares of the par value of fifty dollars each, and may issue its scrip, bonds, or other negotiable promises to aid the purposes of its corporation, and may secure the same, or any part thereof by mortgage of its property and franchise. The work of construction on the extension line authorized by this act shall not begin later than May nineteen, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven.

Capital stock may be increased.
