#### Снар. 52

#### Chapter 52.

An Act to amend section thirteen of chapter four hundred and eighty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to the charter of the Pemaquid, Pamariscotta and Newcastle Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sec. 13, ch. 485, Private Laws of 1893, amended. SECT. 1. Section thirteen of chapter four hundred and eighty-five of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, is hereby amended by striking out the word "two" in section thirteen, and inserting in its place the word 'four,' so that when amended, it shall read as follows:

Charter void, if work is not commenced within four years.

'SECT. 13. This charter shall be null and void, unless operations for building this railroad shall have been actually commenced within four years from date of passage of this act.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

#### Chapter 53.

An Act to amend chapter four hundred and eight of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-five entitled, "An Act to incorporate the city of Biddeford," as amended by chapter nine of the Private Laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, in relation to the election of Constables.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sec. 1, ch. 9, Private Laws of 1857, repealed. Sect. 1. Section one of chapter nine of the private laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved February 21, 1895.
