Chapter 59.

An Act to enable the town of Eliot to immediately avail itself of the provisions of the will of the late John S. H. Fogg of Boston, deceased.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The town of Eliot is authorized to extinguish by purchase or contract the life interest of Mary G. Fogg of Boston, in the library and other property, or any part thereof, of the late John S. H. Fogg, by him devised and bequeathed for the establishment of a free public library upon the Fogg homestead, in said Eliot, to be called The William Fogg Public Library.

May terminate life interest of Mary G. Fogg.

SECT. 2. Said town may, by majority vote, at any annual town meeting, or special town meeting called for the purpose, appropriate money for such extinguishment of said Mary G. Fogg's said life interest, and may authorize the selectmen or town treasurer or any special agent or commissioners to negotiate and arrange settlement with said Mary G. Fogg and with the executor of the will and estate of said deceased, for immediately obtaining the benefits of the provisions of the will of said deceased for the establishment of said free public library, by procuring delivery of said library, and other property, or any part thereof, and necessary and proper deeds of conveyance thereof to the trustees of The William Fogg Public Library.

May raise money and make immediate settlement.

SECT. 3. Said town may, at any annual town meeting or any special town meeting called for the purpose, choose a trustee of The William Fogg Public Library, to hold the office during life, or until a successor is chosen in the same way.

May choose a trustee.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
