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**Chapter 79.**

An Act to amend special act of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An Act to amend chapter ninety-one, section four, of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, relating to the Marshal and Deputy Marshal of the City of Bath."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Chapter two hundred and ninety-one, section four, of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, are hereby amended by striking out the words "deputy marshal"; and also by adding after the word "March" the words, 'or as soon thereafter as conveniently may be'; so that the section as amended, shall read as follows :

Sec. 4, ch. 291,

'SECT. 4. The city marshal of the city of Bath, shall hereafter be annually elected in March, or as soon thereafter as conveniently may be, by the city council; and all policemen, watchmen and constables, shall hereafter be annually appointed by the mayor, by and with the advice and consent of the aldermen.'

**Chapter 80.**

An Act relating to the Portland and Rumford Falls Railway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The Portland and Rumford Falls Railway is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, hold and dispose of shares of capital stock and mortgage bonds of other corporations.
