Chapter 100.

An Act to authorize the building of a Fish Weir at Harbor Island, in the County of Haucock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Charles E. Sprague, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a fish weir on the eastern side of Harbor island, in the county of Hancock, and to extend the same twelve hundred feet into tide waters.

This act shall take effect when approved. SECT. 2.

Chapter 101.

An Act to incorporate the town of Woodville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled as follows:

SECT. 1. Township number two, Indian Purchase, in the SECT. 1. Township number two, Indian Purchase, in the county of Penobscot, and known as Woodville plantation, is ^{Woodville,} incorporated. hereby incorporated into a town by the name of Woodville; and the inhabitants of said town, are hereby vested with all the powers, privileges, immunities and liabilities of other towns.

SECT. 2. Any justice of the peace within the county of Penobscot is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to some inhabitant of said town, directing him to notify the inhabitants thereof to meet at such time and place as he shall appoint, to choose such officers as other towns are empowered to choose at their annual town meetings.

The town hereby created shall take the effects Sect. 3. belonging to Woodville plantation and shall also assume all the obligations of said plantation.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
