Chapter 110.

An Act to extend the charter of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Railway Company, and enable it to cross navigable tide waters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Charter and powers extended for two years.

All the provisions of chapter four hundred seventy-seven of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, relating to the incorporation of the Portland and Yarmouth Electric Railway Company and all the limitations therein contained, are hereby extended for and during the period of two years additional thereto, and the persons named in said act, their successors and assigns, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as provided in this act. Said corporation shall be liable for any damages to water and gas pipes caused by the action of the electric current used by it.

Chapter 111.

An Act to amend the charter of the Bangor, Orono and Old Town Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sec. 13, ch. 116, Private Laws of 1891, amended. SECT. 1. Section thirteen of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the private and special laws for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one is hereby amended by adding thereto the following; 'Any street railroad company whose lines as constructed or chartered would form connecting or continuing lines with the lines of this company is hereby authorized to consolidate with or to lease or sell its lines, property and franchises as in this section authorized,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

May lease property.

-consolidate with other lines. 'Sect. 13. Said corporation is hereby authorized to lease all of its property and franchises on such terms as it may determine. Also to consolidate with or to acquire by lease, purchase or otherwise, the lines, property and franchises of any other street railroad whose lines as constructed or
