CHAP. 168 time when the reduction of its capital stock authorized under the preceding section shall be consummated; but in case of such reduction, all subscribers who shall have paid to said corporation, in cash or its equivalent, fifty per cent of the amount of their respective subscriptions, shall thereafter be relieved from liability thereunder on account of debts which may be contracted by said corporation after such reduction shall have been made.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 168.

An Act to enable the Wesleyan Methodist Society of Augusta to convey its real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The Wesleyan Methodist Society of Augusta is hereby authorized, at a meeting of said society called for that purpose, to empower its president to convey all of the real estate of said society to the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church of Augusta, and their successors in said office to hold the same in trust, subject to the conditions of the original deed of conveyance to said society.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
