Chapter 191.

An Act for the better protection of deer in the counties of Androscoggin and Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Whoever in any manner or at any time within five years of the approval of this act shall hunt, chase, catch, kill or destroy any deer within the counties of Androscoggin and Kennebec forfeits forty dollars for each deer so hunted, chased, killed or destroyed.

Hunting of deer, in Androscoggin and Kennebec counties, prohibited for five years.

Chapter 192.

An Act to ratify and confirm the second mortgage made by the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The second mortgage made by the Bangor and Aroostook Railroad Company, dated February twenty-seventh in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, which runs to the United States Mortgage and Trust Company, trustee, is hereby made valid, ratified and confirmed, so that the same shall, in all respects, be as valid as if the legislative sanction had been obtained before the execution of said mortgage.

Mortgage of B. & A. R. R. Co., made valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
