CHAP. 195

Chapter 195.

An Act to confirm the issue of bonds and other acts of the Salina Water Works Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Organization
and doings of
Salina Water
Works Co.,
made valid.

SECT. 1. The organization of the Salina Water Works Company, and all acts and doings of its stockholders and directors, in purchasing the property and franchises of the Salina Water Works Company, of Salina, Kansas, and its acts and doings in issuing its bonds to the amount of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, secured by mortgage of its franchises and property, so far as the same appear of record, and conform to the purposes of its organization, are hereby confirmed and declared legal and valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 196.

An Act to confirm the issue of bonds, and other acts of the Winfield Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Organization
and doings of
Winfield
Water Co.,
made valid.

SECT. 1. The organization of the Winfield Water Company, and all acts and doings of its stockholders and directors, in purchasing the property and franchises of the Winfield Water Company, of Winfield, Kansas, and in acts and doings in issuing its bonds to the amount of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, secured by mortgage of its franchises and property, so far as the same appear of record, and conform to the purposes of its organization, are hereby confirmed and declared legal and valid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
