LEWISTON-SEWER TAXES.

Chapter 284.

An Act to set off a part of Ward Five and annex the same to Ward Four in the city of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. All that part of ward five, in the city of Lewis-Ward lines, ton, which is bounded as follows: On the north by Ash changed. street, on the east by Horton street, on the south by Walnut street, and on the west by Bates street, is hereby set off from said ward five and annexed to and made a part of ward four, in said city.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 285.

An Act to provide for the assessment of Sewer Taxes in the town of Skowhegan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. All sewer taxes assessed against the abutters of the sewers in the town of Skowhegan not paid on or before sewer taxes. May first eighteen hundred and ninety-five, may be re-assessed against said abutters not paying under and in accordance with chapter two hundred and eighty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, on the same basis that the former assessments were made.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
