## CHAP. 307

**Chapter 307.**

An Act to amend chapter four hundred and thirty-six of the Private and Special Acts of the year eighteen hundred and thirty-four, entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of Bangor."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Sec. 9, ch. 436,  
Private and  
Special acts  
of 1834,  
amended.

SECT. 1. Section nine of chapter four hundred and thirty-six of the private and special acts of the year eighteen hundred and thirty-four entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of Bangor," is hereby amended by striking out the word "majority" in the sixth line of said section nine and inserting in place thereof the word 'plurality,' so that said section nine as amended, shall read as follows :

Officers of  
city, shall be  
elected by a  
plurality of  
votes cast.

'SECT. 9. That the mayor shall be elected by the citizens at large, by the inhabitants of the city voting in their respective wards ; one alderman and three common councilmen shall be elected by each ward, being residents in the ward where they are elected. All said officers shall be elected by ballot by a plurality of the votes given in, and shall hold their offices one year from third Monday of March, and until others are elected and sworn in their places.'

When act  
shall take  
effect.

SECT. 2. This act shall not take effect until the first day of January, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Approved March 26, 1895.

**Chapter 308.**

An Act to authorize the Kennebec Steamboat Company to hold stock in other corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

May hold  
stock in other  
corporations.

SECT. 1. The Kennebec Steamboat Company, a corporation organized under the laws of this state, is hereby authorized to purchase and hold stock in other corporations to an amount not exceeding one-fifth of its capital stock.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 27, 1895.
