Chapter 19.

Resolve in favor of the Hospital of the Society of the Sisters of Charity of Lewiston, Maine.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars to be paid to the society of the Sisters of Charity of Lewiston, Maine, for the use of the hospital of said society for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the use of said institution for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Chapter 20.

Resolve in favor of the town of Warren.

Resolved, That there be paid by the treasurer of state, out of the school fund of the current year, to the town of Warren, the sum of seven hundred and forty-eight dollars and forty-four cents, it being a balance equitably due said town as its proportion of the school funds for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four.

Resolve in favor of Committee on State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred seventeen dollars and fifty cents be paid from the state treasury to M. H. Ferguson, to defray the expense of committee on state prison from Augusta to Thomaston and return.
