Chapter 29.

Resolve in favor of Castine State Normal School.

Resolved, That there be appropriated for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five the sum of two thousand dollars for repairs on the normal school building in Castine. The same to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the normal schools.

Chapter 30.

Resolve in aid of blasting ledge and repairing highway in the town of Concord.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated in aid of blasting ledge and repairing highway in the town of Concord, and that the money be expended under the direction of the county commissioners.

Chapter 31.

Resolve in favor of town of Madawaska.

Resolved, That there be appropriated out of any money in the treasury, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to be used in blasting a ledge, Mount Carmel Rock, so called, situated on the highway road leading to Fort Kent and near the line of the town of Madawaska and Grand Isle, to be expended under direction of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.

Chapter 32.

Resolve authorizing the compilation and publication of the Insurance Laws of Maine.

Resolved, That the insurance commissioner be authorized to compile the insurance and fraternal beneficiary laws of the state, including those enacted during the present session of the legislature, and cause two thousand copies of the same to be printed and bound for the use of his department.
