Resolve in favor of the Old Town City Hospital.

*Resolved*, That there be appropriated the sum of six hundred dollars to be paid the Old Town City Hospital, for the use of said institution for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, and six hundred dollars for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.

**Chapter 63.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine State Pomological Society.

*Resolved*, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated from any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be paid to the Maine State Pomological Society for the years one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three and one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.

**Chapter 64.**

Resolve in favor of Oakfield Plantation.

Oakfield Pl.,  
in favor of.

*Resolved*, That the sum of six hundred twenty dollars and nineteen cents be, and is hereby appropriated to be paid to the treasurer of Oakfield plantation to reimburse said plantation, for money expended for the support of state paupers during the years one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two and one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three.
