**Chapter 83.**

Resolve in favor of North Yarmouth Academy.

*Resolved,* That the sum of five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated annually for two years, to aid North Yarmouth Academy; provided, however, that this appropriation is made upon the express condition that the trustees of said institution shall maintain and keep in operation, for at least twenty-four weeks per year during the continuance of this appropriation, a school equal in rank and grade of teaching, with a first class academy, and provided further, that the governor and council and superintendent of common schools, shall have a right at all times to visit said school when the same shall be in operation; and if in the opinion of the governor and council, said institution at any time hereafter shall fail to fulfill the conditions contained in this resolve, they may in their discretion withhold the appropriation herein granted.

**Chapter 84.**

Resolve in aid of building a bridge in Frenchville.

*Resolved,* That two hundred dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury of state to assist in building a bridge over Blanchard stream, so called, in the town of Frenchville, and when said bridge is completed to the satisfaction of the county, commissioners of Aroostook and they so return, the governor shall draw his warrant for the above amount to the town of Frenchville.
