Chapter 88.

Resolve making an appropriation to meet the deficiency incurred in Destruction of Diseased Cattle.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-seven hundred and sixty-six dollars and eighty-six cents, be and hereby is appropriated to pay the deficiency incurred by the destruction of cattle affected with contagious disease as provided by law.

Diseased cattle, deficiency in appropriation, provided for.

Chapter 89.

Resolve providing for the purchase and distribution of Savage's Index-Digest of the Maine Reports.

Resolved, That the state librarian, under the supervision of the governor and council, be and he is hereby authorized to contract for the purchase of eight hundred copies of Savage's Index-Digest of the Maine Reports at a sum not exceeding six dollars per copy, said digest to be equal in paper, printing and binding to Plaisted and Appleton's Digest; and the state librarian is hereby required to distribute said digest the same as Maine Reports are by law distributed, and among the several towns and plantations, public libraries within the state, and such other public institutions as may desire the same, and he may use the same for exchanges.

Chapter 90.

Resolve in favor of the Committee on State Reform School.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be directed to pay to George W. Stone, chairman of said committee, the sum of one hundred and nine dollars and twenty cents, the same being the amount paid out for expenses of the committee on its recent visit to that institution.
