Chapter 107.

Resolve in favor of the county of Androscoggin.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars be, and hereby is appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be paid to the treasurer of the county of Androscoggin, for the use of said county, the same being a reimbursement to said county for moneys paid the county commissioners of said county for services in apportioning the taxes between the towns of Poland, Mechanic Falls and Minot.

Resolved, That the sum of fifty-eight dollars and eight cents be and hereby is appropriated to reimburse George H. Hunt, agent of the Penobscot tribe of Indians, for moneys expended by him for the use of said tribe and not provided for by any other appropriation.
