Chapter 412.

An Act to change the name of the Alonzo Wing Library Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. The action of the Alonzo Wing Library Association, taken November thirty, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, whereby the name of said association was changed to the Wayne Library Association, is hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.

Name changed to Wayne Library Association.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rights or liabilities of said association.

Rights and liabilities.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 413.

An Act relating to Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Sabattus Water Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sect. 1. The rights, powers and privileges, granted by chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Sabattus Water Company," are hereby extended for and during the term of two years from March six, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven; and the time within which said corporation may construct and put in operation some portion of its works is hereby extended for the term of two years from March six, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.

Charter extended two years.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
