Chapter 468.

An Act to provide for the retirement of members of the Fire Department of the City of Portland upon half pay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

City authorized to retire and pension members of fire department.

The city council, of the city of Portland, are hereby authorized to provide by ordinance for the retirement, upon a pension not exceeding half pay, of members of the fire department who have served not less than twenty-five years in a position in the fire department requiring them to give to its duties their whole time, and who have been honorably discharged by reason of age, or of permanent physical incapacity which is the result of an incident of service.

Chapter 469.

An Act to repeal Chapter five hundred and eighty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and Chapter sixty-five of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy eight, relating to Swett's Pond, Field's Pond and Brewer's Pond in Orrington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter 580, private laws, 1868, and chapter 65, laws, 1878, repealed. Chapter five hundred and eighty of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and chapter sixty-five of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and seventyeight are hereby repealed.

Chapter 470.

An Act to amend Chapter one hundred and fifty-four of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-rive, relating to the charter of the Wiscasset Water Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Charter amended.

Section nine of chapter one hundred and fifty-four of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, is hereby amended as follows: the word "two" in the first line of said section is stricken out and the word 'four' inserted, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
