CHAP. 199

Chapter 199.

Resolve in favor of Cherryfield Academy.

Cherryfield
Academy,
in favor of.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars be, and is hereby appropriated, annually, for the term of two years, to aid Cherryfield academy; provided, however, that this appropriation is made upon the express condition that the trustees of said institution shall maintain and keep in operation for at least twenty-four weeks per year, a school equal in rank and grade of teaching with a first class academy; and that if in the opinion of the governor and council, said institution shall fail to fulfill this condition they may, in their discretion, withhold the appropriation herein granted.

Chapter 200.

Resolve in favor of Leavitt Institute.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars per year for a period of two years, be and hereby is appropriated, to be paid to the trustees of Leavitt institute of Turner, for educational purposes.

Chapter 201.

Resolve in favor of Westbrook Seminary.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid Westbrook seminary for the use and benefit of that institution, for each of the years eighteen hundred and ninety-seven and eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, the sum of two thousand dollars.
