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**Chapter 255.**

Resolve laying a tax on counties of the state for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-seven and eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

*Resolved*, That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same, and for other purposes ordered by law; for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, Androscoggin, forty thousand dollars; Aroostook, sixty thousand dollars; Cumberland, ninety thousand dollars; Franklin, twelve thousand nine hundred dollars; Hancock, twenty-one thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-five thousand six hundred forty-one dollars and fifty-eight cents; Knox, twenty-five thousand dollars; Lincoln, nine thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars; Oxford, twenty-two thousand one hundred dollars; Penobscot, forty thousand dollars; Piscataquis, ten thousand dollars; Sagadahoc, fifteen thousand dollars; Somerset, sixteen thousand dollars; Waldo, seventeen thousand five hundred dollars; Washington, thirty thousand dollars; York, thirty-five thousand dollars; and for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, Androscoggin, forty thousand dollars; Aroostook, sixty thousand dollars; Cumberland, ninety thousand dollars; Franklin, twelve thousand nine hundred dollars; Hancock, twenty-one thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-five thousand six hundred forty-one dollars and fifty-eight cents; Knox, twenty-five thousand dollars; Lincoln, nine thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars; Oxford, twenty-two thousand one hundred dollars; Penobscot, forty thousand dollars; Piscataquis, ten thousand dollars; Sagadahoc, thirteen thousand dollars; Somerset, sixteen thousand dollars; Waldo, seventeen thousand five hundred dollars; Washington, forty thousand dollars; York, thirty-five thousand dollars.
