Section 7. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 414.

An Act to extend the charter of the Manufacturers' Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the Manufacturers' Trust Company, which were granted by chapter twelve extended of the private and special laws for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 415.

An Act to amend "An Act to establish a Municipal Court in the Town of Waterville."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Chapter two hundred and twenty of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, as amended by chapter three hundred and twenty-nine of the private and special watervine laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one, and by chapter four hundred and eighty-two of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, and by chapter twenty-nine of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and by chapter three hundred and twenty-five of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, is hereby further amended by adding to the end of section fourteen the following sentence, 'and except over criminal offenses arising outside of said city, for which trial justices may hold their courts within said city of Waterville,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
