Chapter 8.

An Act to amend Section forty-seven of Chapter seventy-seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to the times of holding terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in Knox County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 47, chapter 77 of R. S., as amended by section 2, chapter 253, laws of 1901, further amended.

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes, as amended by section two of chapter two hundred and fifty-three of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred and one, is hereby amended so that that paragraph of said section relating to the times of holding the terms of the supreme judicial court in the county of Knox shall read as follows:

—when terms of supreme judicial court shall be held in Knox county.

‘Knox, at Rockland, on the first Tuesday of January, first Tuesday of April, and the third Tuesday of September.’

Matters commenced before or after this act takes effect shall be entered at the term substituted by this act.

Section 2. All matters commenced before or after this act takes effect and returnable to and all matters pending in said court, and which would, but for the provisions of this act, be entered and have day at the term of said court to be held on the second Tuesday of March, in the year of our Lord, nineteen hundred and three, as provided by law, shall be entered and have day at the term of the supreme judicial court in said county to be held on the first Tuesday of April, in the year of our Lord, nineteen hundred and three which is substituted by this act for the said March term, and shall have day therein as if originally made returnable to said April term; and any provisions of law applicable to any term of court, the time of holding whereof is changed by this act, are hereby made applicable to the substituted term.

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
