Chapter 43.

An Act to repeal Sections fourteen and seventeen, Chapter eight of the Revised Statutes, relating to duties of County Treasurers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 14 and section 17 of chapter 8 of R. S., repealed.

Section 1. Section fourteen and section seventeen of chapter eight of the revised statutes are hereby repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 44.

An Act to repeal Section nine of Chapter thirteen of the Revised Statutes, relating to the practice of Medicine and Surgery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 9 of chapter 13 of R. S., repealed.

Section 1. Section nine, chapter thirteen of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 45.

An Act to amend Section twelve of Chapter three of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter three hundred and thirty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five and to repeal conflicting statutes, relating to the election of Collectors of Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 12 of chapter 3, public laws of 1885, further amended.

—collector of taxes not eligible as treasurer.

Section 1. Section twelve of chapter three of the revised statutes as amended by chapter three hundred and thirty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: 'nor shall a collector be eligible to or hold the office of treasurer until he has completed his duties under his warrant and had a final settlement with the town.'

Inconsistent acts repealed.

Section 2. Section one hundred and seventy-six of chapter six of the revised statutes and all other acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the preceding section, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
